NATIONAL PRECAST FLOORING TRAINING SCHEME

The National Training Scheme for the Erection of Precast Concrete Flooring and Associated Components

The Precast Flooring Federation (PFF) is committed to providing effective training for all employees in all areas of the industry.

One of the key areas for training is ensuring that all fixing operatives are competent to do the job. This includes knowing how to operate the equipment that is used as part of the job and knowing the relevant rules and codes of practice.

The PFF has arranged for all National Precast Flooring training to be arranged through Proskills. This means that training standards will be maintained wherever and whenever the training is carried out

The National Precast Flooring Training Scheme (NPFT Scheme) includes very specific requirements for the duration and content of training, the requirements for passing the course and how many people may be trained in one session

The Scheme offers the following benefits:-

The training modules are designed to provide competency and evidence for the N/SVQ Level 2 Installation of Precast Concrete - a requirement of the CSCS Card Scheme.

The Scheme will provide training that will be consistent and standardised throughout the industry and can be used by new entrants and existing experienced employees for refresher training. In the future the scheme will eventually be expanded into other areas such as the N/SVQ/CSCS requirements for Foreman and Supervisors

The Scheme is managed by a recognised industry lead body within the sector and includes training specifications for:-

- Basic Safety Awareness ▷ Working at Height ▷ Cut Off Saw/Abrasive Wheels
- Manual Handling ▷ The PFF Codes of Practice ▷ CPCS Slings and Signalling
